Be it ordained by the City of Lake Annette Board of Aldermen as follows:

This Agreement is made and entered into this 7th day of August, 1995 by and between the Board of Aldermen of Lake Annette, Missouri, hereinafter known as "Lake Annette", and the County Commission of Cass County, Missouri, hereinafter known as "Cass County", both political subdivisions within the state of Missouri; and

WHEREAS, The Revised Statutes of Missouri, as amended, permits contracts and agreements between political subdivisions, and

WHEREAS, the parties desire to maintain for citizens of Lake Annette, Missouri, the maximum benefits of an emergency telephone system (9-1-1) for the protection of life and property during emergencies, such as fires, emergency medical incidents, rescue incidents, hazardous material occurrences, and natural disasters, and

WHEREAS the parties desire to maintain for citizens of Lake Annette, Missouri, efficient processing and arrival of United States Postal Service mail and other deliveries, and

WHEREAS, the parties agree that standard street naming and structure addressing are critical for maximum benefits of said emergency telephone system and are critical for efficient processing and arrival of United States Postal Service mail and other deliveries, and

WHEREAS, Cass County works with the local telephone exchange companies and the United States Postal Service to maintain street and customer databases for unincorporated areas of Cass County Missouri

THEREFORE, IT IS MUTUALLY AGREED, for and in consideration of the agreements between the selected parties, that:

1. Lake Annette shall officially adopt a Standard Addressing Convention that includes the following:
 - A. Standard Street Naming Conventions, including pre and postdirectionals, suffixes, and secondary address identifiers;
 - B. Standard Address Assignment Conventions, including secondary addresses;
 - C. Rules and regulations for changing the Standard Addressing Convention;

- D. Rules and regulations for changing a particular street or address, including all the street or address components.
2. Lake Annette agrees to adopt the United States Postal Service's Postal Addressing Standards in Lake Annette's Standard Addressing Convention.
 3. Lake Annette shall supply Cass County with Lake Annette's officially adopted Standard Addressing Convention.
 4. Lake Annette shall supply Cass County in writing, Lake Annette's street names, including pre and postdirectionals, suffixes, and secondary address identifiers, for all appropriate streets inside the corporate boundaries of Lake Annette, Missouri.
 5. Lake Annette shall supply Cass County in writing, Lake Annette's address address assignments, including secondary addresses for all appropriate structures inside the corporate boundaries of Lake Annette, Missouri.
 6. Lake Annette shall designate in writing, a single individual to coordinate the activities included herein this agreement, including the daily resolution of discrepant telephone subscriber information in the local telephone exchange company's database.
 7. Cass County will work with the local telephone exchange company and the United States Postal Service to maintain a street and customer database for incorporated areas of Lake Annette, Missouri.
 8. Lake Annette shall pay for notification of all parties involved with the activities included directly and indirectly herein this agreement.
 9. Lake Annette shall erect street signs indicating the names of Lake Annette's Streets.
 10. Lake Annette shall receive and resolve all citizens complaints with Lake Annette's street names and addressing assignments.
 11. Lake Annette shall coordinate with Cass County on mutual matters such as naming common streets, placement of street signs on county rights-of-way, e
 12. Lake Annette shall adopt an ordinance requiring address assignments be posted pursuant to S 67.318 Revised Statutes of Missouri, as amended.
