Ordinance No. 20005

AN ORDINANCE TO PROHIBIT TRESPASSING WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS OF THE CITY OF LAKE ANNETTE, MISSOURI.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF LAKE ANNETTE, MISSOURI AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1: No person shall knowingly enter upon, or knowingly remain in a building or upon a private dock or upon the real property of another.
- Section 2: Notice of trespass - No person shall be convicted of a violation of this section in regard to the entering upon or remaining upon the dock or real property of another unless the property is fenced or otherwise enclosed in a manner designed to exclude the intruder or as to which notice against trespass is given by:
- A. Actual communication with the intruder or
  - B. Posting in a manner reasonably likely to come to the attention of the intruder.
- Section 3: Tampering with signs described in Section 2: No person shall tamper with or destroy any sign as described in Section 2 hereof.
- Section 4: Any person who violates the terms of this ordinance shall, upon conviction, be fined not more than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500) or imprisoned in the county jail for not to exceed ninety (90) days, or by both fine and imprisonment.
- Section 5: This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval.
