

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LAKE ANNETTE, MISSOURI CERTIFYING THE RESULTS OF THE APRIL 3, 2018, ELECTION.

Whereas, a General Municipal Election was held in and for the City of Lake Annette on Tuesday, April 3, 2018

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF LAKE ANNETTE, MISSOURI AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: It is hereby found and determined by a canvass of the votes by the Board of Aldermen, City of Lake Annette, Missouri, at the election held on April 3, 2018, in conformity with the Revised Statutes of Missouri and the Ordinances of the City of Lake Annette as follows:

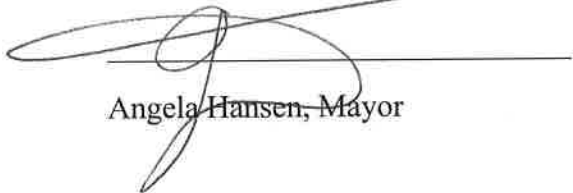

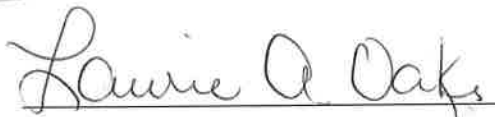
