

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LAKE ANNETTE, MISSOURI CERTIFYING THE RESULTS OF THE JUNE 2, 2020 ELECTION.

WHEREAS A General Municipal Election was held in and for the City of Lake Annette, Missouri on Tuesday, June 2, 2020.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF FREEMAN, MISSOURI AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1 – It is hereby found and determined by a canvass of the votes by the Board of Aldermen of Lake Annette, Missouri, at the election held on June 2, 2020, in conformity with the Revised Statutes of Missouri and Ordinances of the City of Lake Annette as follows:

The Board of Aldermen does find that Pete Hart and Edna Burns are the candidates for Alderman-at-Large received the highest number of votes, and shall hold the office for two years, until successors are duly elected or appointed and qualified according to law.

SECTION 4 - That all ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 5 – The effective date of this Ordinance shall be the 16th day of June 2020.
